The book cover is a 100-point assignment. It will be **due on Friday, August 24, 2018**.

Front Cover (15 points): Should contain the book title, author's name, colored illustration, and your name. The illustration must be original and not be a copy of the existing cover art. It should be eye-catching and reflect an important part of the book. Illustrations should be hand drawn and colored in pencils or markers.

Inside Front Cover Flap (15 points): Neatness counts, you may consider typing up each section and gluing it into your project. Top $\frac{2}{3}$ of flap should contain descriptions of 2 or 3 of the book's main characters. Each summary should be at least 3-5 sentences long. Include information that is unique about the character and why they are important in the book. You will also want to use strong adjectives to describe the character. Words like intelligent, sneaky, and honest are better than nice, happy, and pretty to describe your character.(10) On the bottom $\frac{1}{3}$ of the flap, draw a picture of the character(s) in a scene from the book.(5)

Book Spine (15 pts): Use creative lettering to design a spine for your book jacket. (6)
 Include the title of the book and the author's name (6)
 Write the name of the publisher at the bottom of the panels (3)

Back Cover (20 points): On top half of the panel, include the title and author and the publishing company. (5)

In the middle - Write a 3 paragraph summary from the book that highlights the beginning, middle, and the end of the book. Remember, this summary states the facts, not what you thought about the book. Don't include personal opinions, but rather the information about the **setting, plot, the characters, and the main conflicts** that occur in the book.(10)

On the bottom part of the panel, include an important quote from the on of the characters or the narrator. This quote should reflect on an important idea or theme from the book. (5)

Students, we expect to read your original work. Do not refer to a website or summary generated by someone else on the internet. We check each report for academic honesty.

Inside Rear Cover Flap-(15 points) In a detailed paragraph, describe three meaningful ways you can relate to the protagonist of the novel you read. Give text evidence to support your ideas and give details to indicate that you thought about this character in detailed ways.

Spelling/ Grammar -(10 points)

Overall creativity And Neatness- creative and colorful- and neatly put together - I can read it easily (5 points)

Construction - use sturdy paper such as poster board or cardboard, any sections glued on are firmly attached and not dog-eared(5 points)
