## *Cell Phone, MP3 Players, and Other Electronic Devices*

### School Policy

Students are not allowed to have cell phones or other electronic devices on their person during the school day (graphing and dedicated calculators are the only exceptions). If discovered, these devices are subject to reasonable inspection, which may include review of history and any information contained on the device. A student refusing to handover an electronic device may be subject to additional school discipline as deemed appropriate. Confiscated devices may be required to be picked up in the Main Office by a parent/guardian.

If an extreme medical emergency arises, parents may contact the school administration and request their child be allowed to be in possession of their cell phone during the school day. **However, permission must be granted to the parent by the school administrator prior to the student being allowed to carry the cell phone during the school day.**

**NOTE: Tecumseh Local School District and their employees are not responsible for damages, theft or loss of student property including electronic devices.**

**NOTE: Any evidence found which might indicate activity that goes against school policy or state law, will be handled by the appropriate authority.**

- 2<sup>nd</sup> violation ..... 3 ALC
- 3<sup>rd</sup> violation ..... 3 OSS
- 4<sup>th</sup> violation ..... 5 OSS
