Dear Graduate and Family:

The Administration would like to extend our congratulations to the Tecumseh High School Graduating Class of 2019. As we prepare for the end of your senior year, you are probably excited about the possibilities that the future holds. However, there are some significant information, dates, and locations that will concern you with graduation quickly approaching.

Graduation

Date: Sunday, June 2, 2019, at 2:00 p.m.
(Seniors need to arrive at 12:30 p.m.)

Place: Ervin J. Nutter Center, Wright State University

Dress: Men should wear dress slacks, dress shirt and tie. Ladies will need to wear a lightweight dress/skirt or dress slacks. Appropriate footwear should be worn, no flip-flops or tennis shoes. **If you have not ordered your cap and gown, you need to call Josten's at (937) 280-4350 IMMEDIATELY!** The men will wear black robes and the ladies will wear red robes. If you do not have the proper cap and gown, you will not be able to march in the graduation ceremony.

Practice: Thursday, May 30, 2019, at 8:00 a.m. Seniors should arrive at the E.J. Nutter Center, Wright State University no later than 8:00 a.m. Seniors will park in lot 9, 6, or 5 for both practice on May 30 and the graduation ceremony on June 2. Seniors will enter through gate 9, McLin Gym entrance.

PLEASE NOTE: This practice is **MANDATORY** for all students who plan to participate in the ceremony. Please be prompt in arriving and practice should be completed by 11:30 a.m. Practice will count as a day of attendance for school purposes.

Diploma: Diplomas may be picked-up at the conclusion of the graduation ceremony. They will be available in the area behind the stage.

Tickets: Tickets are no longer required. However, preferred seating location is based on first come basis. If you have someone who will be attending the ceremony that would have difficulty with the bleacher seating, such as in a wheelchair, a limited number of seats will be available on the floor. These will be assigned on a first come basis. We request that the floor seating be for the individual unable to sit in the normal seating area and one other individual – not the whole family. Please use the gate 9, McLin Gym entrance, for handicap seating.

Obligations: Seniors with any outstanding obligations for this year and/or past years must clear them no later than **Friday, May 10, 2019**. Failure to clear such obligations will result in the withholding of the student's diploma and denial of participation in the graduation ceremony.


Photography: LifeTouch Photography will be taking pictures of the seniors with their diploma cover. These pictures will be available for purchase and LifeTouch will contact you by mail within a few weeks after graduation.

Behavior: Please be respectful of all graduates and their families, as they wait to hear their student's name read and watch the "official" presentation of the diploma. For this reason, we ask that movement and noise be kept to a minimum during this time. The Nutter Center does not allow activities during the program that detract from the ceremony (beach balls, silly string, super balls, marbles, noise makers, toilet paper, etc.). Nutter Center security personnel will remove anyone from the ceremony who is/becomes involved in this type of activity and/or is in violation of the district discipline codes.

Please see that your guidance counselor knows about any scholarships being offered to you. Guidance needs this information by May 3, 2019, for newspaper publications and graduation acknowledgements.

Graduates:

Enter the E.J. Nutter Center from Raider Rd. Follow the signs to the left side of the Nutter Center and park in Lot 9. Overflow parking will be in Lot 6 and Lot 5.

Enter the building using Gate 9 (McLin Gym) and report to the staging area at the back of the arena.

Handicapped:

Enter the E.J. Nutter Center from Raider Rd. Follow the signs to the left side of the Nutter Center and park in Lot 9, Lot 6, or Lot 5.

Enter the building using Gate 9 (McLin Gym) and report to the staging area at the back of the arena to be escorted to your seats. If you enter at the main entrance, an attendant will escort you to your seats on the floor.

Family/Guests:

Enter the E.J. Nutter Center from Raider Rd. Follow the signs to Lot 1 or Lot 3. Enter at the main entrance to the E.J. Nutter Center and proceed to the seating area of the arena.

- Turn left onto University Blvd
- Turn left onto Raider Rd and follow to the Nutter Center

From the South

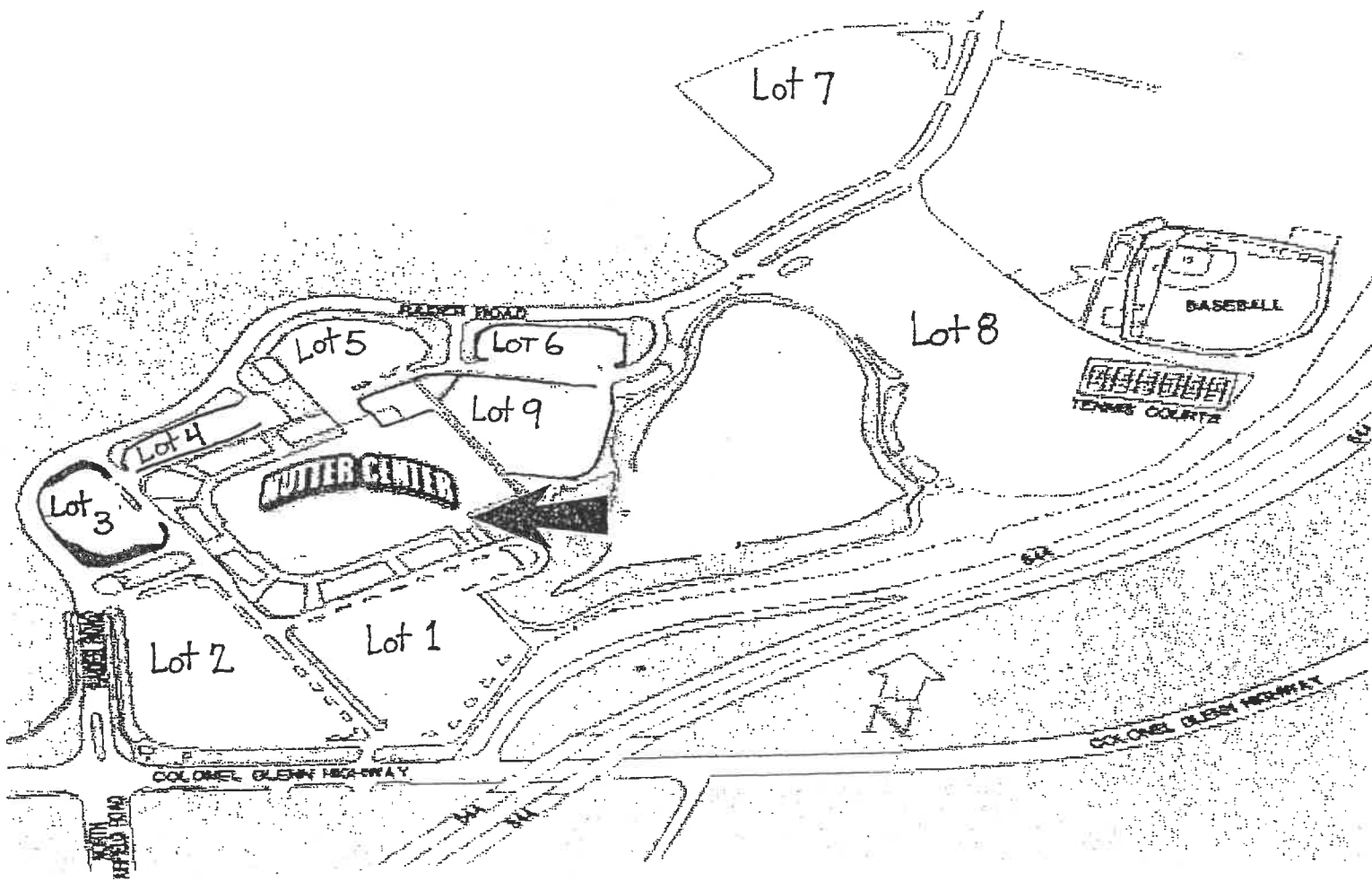
- Take I-75 North to I-675 North
- Take I-675 to Exit 17, follow the sign for "WPAFB Areas A&C" and "Wright St. Univ."
- Get off at Wright State University exit
- Turn left onto University Blvd
- Turn left onto Raider Rd and follow to the Nutter Center

From the East

- Take I-70 West to I-675 South
- Take N Fairfield Rd exit (17)
- Turn right onto N Fairfield Rd
- Turn right at Col Glenn Hwy
- Turn right onto on-ramp for 844 North, and get off at Wright State University exit
- Turn left onto University Blvd
- Turn left onto Raider Rd and follow to the Nutter Center

From the West

- Take I-70 East to I-675 South
- Take I-675 to N Fairfield Rd exit (17)
- Turn right onto N Fairfield Rd
- Turn right at Col Glenn Hwy
- Turn right onto on-ramp for 844 North, and get off at Wright State University exit
- Turn left onto University Blvd
- Turn left onto Raider Rd and follow to the Nutter Center
