Ohio State University GLBT Scholarship Program – March 1, 2012

For the past decade, the Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgender (GLBT) Alumni Society has offered scholarships to students in recognition of their service and leadership in the GLBT community or HIV/AIDS community. Additional scholarships exist for GLBT students who plan to study music, who have financial need, or have worked in the HIV and AIDS community. OSBA Black Caucus of School Board Stipend – March 16, 2012

The Leo Lucas Stipend is for any graduating minority (African American) student with a desire to attend an Ohio College. Applicant must have a 2.5 GPA. Applications are available in the Guidance Office or online at www.ohioschoolboards.org/ohio-black-caucus

The Willie and Eloise Root Memorial Scholarship- March 23, 2012

The Willie and Eloise Root Memorial Scholarship was established in 2007 by Louise Van Vliet for the exclusive purpose of assisting individuals to further their studies at an accredited college, community college, university, vocational school or trade program. Miss Van Vliet wished to honor the memory of these migrant workers whom she met and became friends with one summer while she was working at an apple orchard. This scholarship targets two groups of people: • Must be a migrant worker, a child of a migrant worker, or a high school senior or currently enrolled college student who can demonstrate an active role in the lives of migrant workers OR • Be a victim of human trafficking, a child of someone who is a victim of human trafficking, or a high school senior or currently enrolled college student who can demonstrate an active role in activism against human trafficking • Must plan to pursue a degree from an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or technical school in the state of Ohio • Must have a 2.5 GPA. based on a 4.0 scale or have successfully completed a GED • Demonstrate financial need.
