Clark State's Trustee Scholarship – March 30, 2012

This scholarship is for full tuition. Eligibility: 3.5 GPA or top 15% of class; exhibit community and extracurricular involvement. Application available in the Guidance Office or online www.clarkstate.edu/scholarships.php
