#### H. Resolution of Assurance

The Tecumseh Local Board of Education must pass a resolution of assurance regarding compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act 1964, Title IX of the Education Amendment 1973, Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1975, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, and all regulations, guidelines, and standards under the above statutes lawfully adopted by the U.S. Department of Education. #### K. Service Fund

#### Ohio Revised Code 3315.15 Service Fund Set Aside

Any city, local, or exempted village board of education may by resolution set aside each year from the general fund a sum not to exceed two dollars for each child enrolled in the district, or twenty thousand dollars, whichever is greater. Any educational service center governing board may by resolution set aside each year from the educational service center fund a sum not to exceed twenty thousand dollars. The amount set aside shall be placed in a fund known as the "service fund," which shall be used only in paying the expenses of members of such boards of education and educational service center governing boards actually incurred in the performance of their duties, or in paying the expenses of members-to-be of such boards actually incurred in training and orientation to the performance of their duties from the date of election or appointment to the date of administration of the oath of office. Such payments shall be made only in such amount as may be approved by the board on statement of the several members or members-to-be furnished at the next succeeding regular meeting of such board. No board shall appropriate or expend a sum greater than sixty thousand dollars in any one school year from such service fund.

# TECUMSEH LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT 9760 W NATIONAL RD., NEW CARLISLE, OH 45344 RESOLUTION TO ALLOW ARMED STAFF IN SCHOOL SAFETY ZONE

WHEREAS the Tecumseh Local School District Board of Education believes that the safety of their students and staff is paramount; and

WHEREAS the Tecumseh Local School District Board of Education believes that volunteer administrators, teachers, and school support staff with appropriate training are capable to defend and protect students and that such protection is essential in creating and preserving a proper learning environment;

WHEREAS, the Ohio legislature has authorized a board of education to grant written authorization to such individuals provided the Tecumseh Local School District Board of Education notifies the public by whatever means the affected school regularly communicates with the public and;

WHEREAS, the Ohio legislature has authorized a board of education to grant written authorization to such individuals provided the Tecumseh Local School District Board of Education Board pays all fees associated with the training received and submits a current list of authorized personnel to the Ohio School Safety Center; and

WHEREAS, the Board has the authority and obligation to support staff while engaged in certain governmental actions, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 2744.07.

THEREFORE, for the welfare and safety of students and staff, be it resolved that the Tecumseh Local School District Board of Education, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 2923.122(D)(1)(d) and TLSD board policy number 3217, grants written authorization to approved personnel who meet the requirements of Ohio Revised Code Section 5502.703 to convey deadly weapons or dangerous ordnance into a school safety zone, or to possess a deadly weapon or dangerous ordnance in a school safety zone of the Tecumseh Local School District.

Through this resolution, the Board further notifies the public that the Board has authorized one or more persons to go armed within a school operated by the Board.

The Board directs the Superintendent to create procedures for qualified individuals to be approved and trained, which shall include the following requirements:

- Participation in this program is voluntary and limited (to certain individuals who are approved by the Superintendent);
- No staff member shall regularly carry firearms on their person other than School Resource Officers (SROs);
- Firearms (other than those carried by SROs) are secured in a locked safe; and
- All individuals who are authorized will:
  - Complete and pass the required 24-hour training with the Ohio School Safety Center and any additional subsequent training as determined by the District safety team;
  - Pass a psychological assessment;
  - Pass a yearly background check; and
  - Complete a minimum of 8 hours of training to recertify;
- All training costs will be paid by the Board and approved by the Safety Committee, and all training hours approved by the Board shall be compensated at the employee's hourly/summer rate.

The Board also directs the Superintendent to submit a current list of authorized personnel to the Ohio School Safety and Crisis Center, which shall not be disclosed and shall not be considered a public record.
