Born in Ironton, Ohio , November 1925

Graduated St. Joe High School

Served in the U.S. Navy- World War II on L.S.T. 1029

Married Erma Fields in 1946. Joe and Erma have one daughter, Sharon.

Moved to Medway in 1948 to pursue a future in the construction business. Learned drafting at Wittenberg University.

From 1948 to 1987 worked for several construction businesses: Timmons, Butt & Head, Sutherly Brothers, and Fryman & Cooke. A few construction jobs included: remodeled or additions to : Wilbur Force University, WPAFB Hospital, Centerville High School, Central State University and Springfield South High School. Joe was also instrumental in the building of Fairborn Park Hills (now Fairborn H.S.), Northmont High School Stadium, Greene Hall @ Greene Memorial Hospital, and the Winterfest at Kings Island.

In the mid-50's, became involved with the Medway Little League through the mid-60's.

From 1965 - 1970, Joe was a "Busy" cheerleading Dad: Projects, Transportation, Fund-raisers, etc.
