## END OF THE YEAR INFORMATION

As the school year is winding down, there are several things we need to address:

**School fees** - must be paid in full (\$25) in order for the student to receive their grade card. Please call 845-4465 with any questions.

**Lost or damaged library / textbooks** - Students need to check with the library and with their teachers to make sure they have no lost or damaged books. If so, they will need to settle all obligations by year end.

## 8<sup>th</sup> GRADE KINGS ISLAND REWARD

The end of the year reward for students in grade 8 will be a trip to Kings Island, sponsored by Arrows Parent Nation. Students will have the chance to qualify for this reward trip by following all the guidelines set up by the teachers. The date for the trip is May 16. Kings Island will not accept passes; cost is \$31.

## 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> YEAR END POOL REWARD

This year, the end of the year reward will be a field trip to New Carlisle Pool. Students in grades 6 & 7 will have the chance to qualify for this reward trip by following all the guidelines set up by the teachers. Dates for those trips will be May 20 for 6<sup>th</sup> grade, May 17 for 7<sup>th</sup> grade and a rain date May 21.

## ATTENTION 6<sup>th</sup> GRADE PARENTS & GUARDIANS

There are immunization requirements by the Ohio Department of Health for entry to the 7th grade. All students entering the 7th grade must receive one dose of Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis) and one dose of MCV4 (meningococcal conjugate vaccine 4 strain protection) prior to entering 7th grade. These requirements are in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 33133.671. Your child may have already had these vaccines, so please check with your healthcare provider. Documentation of these vaccines can be turned into the school now. Please make sure that your child has had these vaccines prior to the start of 7th grade. Students will be excluded 14 days after the start of school if these requirements are not met. Thank you for your prompt attention and cooperation in this matter. Have a fun and safe summer.
