## Positive Reinforcements for Good Behavior:

- 1. Activity days for students who have not received write-ups for the month.
- 2. Red Tickets, Arrow Cards, PBS Rewards, individual classroom teacher rewards

After carefully weighing and investigating all facts, possible suspension of expulsion may be implemented on any infraction of the Student Code of Conduct if deemed necessary by the Administration depending on severity. Any action judged by School Officials to invlove misconduct and not specifically mentioned in other sections may be dealt with as insubordination.
