Science Seal

Score of 3 or higher on **BIOLOGY EOC**

or

Score of 2 or higher on a science **Advanced Placement test**, such as AP Physics

or

"B" or higher in science CCP (college) course

Citizenship Seal

Score of 3 or higher on <u>both</u> the **American History and American Government EOC**

or

Score of 2 or higher on a science **Advanced Placement test**, such as AP Government

or

"B" or higher in a US History of American Government CCP (college) course

Military Seal

Provide evidence that you have **enlisted** in a branch of the U.S Armed Forces or participate in the JROTC program for two years.

<u>OhioMeansJobs</u> <u>Readiness Seal</u>

Meet the <u>requirements</u> established by the state for this seal by demonstration of work-readiness and professional skills.

Industry-Recognized Seal

Earn an approved <u>industry-recognized credential</u> (Usually through a CTC program)

Biliteracy Seal

Meet the <u>requirements</u>, including proficiency on assessments in a World Language and English

College Readiness Seal

ACT subtest scores (18 English, 22 Math, and 22 Reading) or SAT subtest scores (480 Reading/Writing and 530 Math)

Technology Seal

Score of 2 or higher on a science **Advanced Placement test**, such as AP Computer Science

or

"B" or higher in an appropriate CCP (college) course

or

Complete a technology course that meets the criteria established by the ODE

Honors Diploma Seal

Students must meet all but one of the following:

4 units of English	3 units of one foriegn language or 2 units of two different foriegn languages
4 units of Math	1 unit of Fine Arts
4 units of Science	3.5 GPA
4 units of Social Studies	27 ACT/1280 SAT

<u>Community Service</u> <u>Seal</u>

Students must complete 60 hours of approved community service

Student Engagement Seal

Student participation in sports, Student Council, FFA, Hope Squad, or Principal–Student Advisory

Fine Arts and Performing Seal

*3 years of art class and participation in art shows *4 years of choir/band and participation in 2 voluntary outside events
