Olive Branch School Resolution

to approve the following resolution of intent regarding the Olive Branch School, as presented:

RESOLUTION OF INTENT REGARDING THE OLIVE BRANCH SCHOOL

The Superintendent recommends that the Board indicate its intent to allow the Olive Branch School Preservation Society to use the Olive Branch School building and to express its intent in a letter of understanding directed to the Olive Branch School Preservation Society.

Rationale:

- 1. The District is currently using the Olive Branch School for storage, and the Olive Branch School Preservation Society has expressed an interest in pursuing grants to restore the building and to lease the building for use as a community and historical resource center.
- 2. Submitting grant applications requires an intent of the Board to permit the Olive Branch School Preservation Society to use and improve the building.

3. After reviewing applicable laws for use of real property owned by the Board, the Board can continue to use the building for administrative purposes, such as storage, and enter into a lease agreement for use of space by others, with a reservation of rights for use by the Board for spaces within the building.

4. The Board wishes to support the efforts of the Olive Branch School Preservation Society to improve the building and to allow it to use the building, with reserved rights for the District to continue to store items in the building and to use spaces as needed.

The Board resolves to authorize the Superintendent to prepare, with the assistance of legal counsel, a letter of intent regarding use of the Olive Branch School building and to send the letter to the Olive Branch School Preservation Society.
