Volunteers will need to have a background check at the Tecumseh Local Schools board office prior to volunteering. Personnel are available to complete background checks between 7:30 - 3:30 Monday-Friday. You do need your driver's license to have your background check completed. Prior to volunteering, you will meet with the building principal who will discuss protocols and expectations for volunteers.
