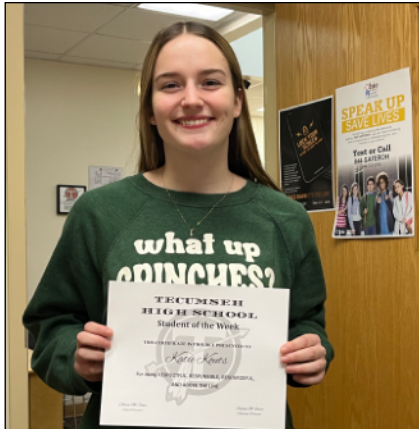
Tecumseh Hosts Annual Holiday Lunch for Local Senior Citizens

Senior Zeke Williford has also been selected Student of the Week for November 27. Zeke was nominated by Mrs.

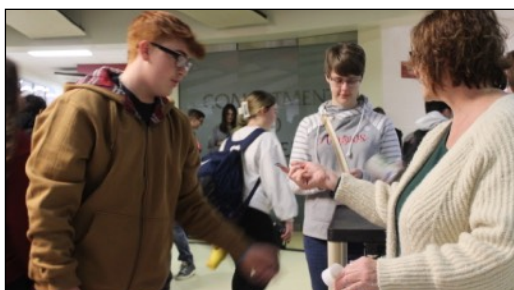
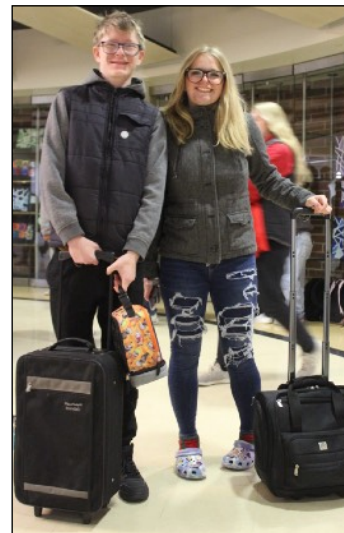
