Sixth Grade Choir Kicks Off Holiday Concerts

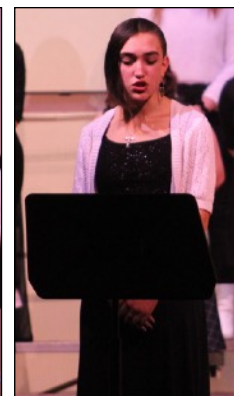

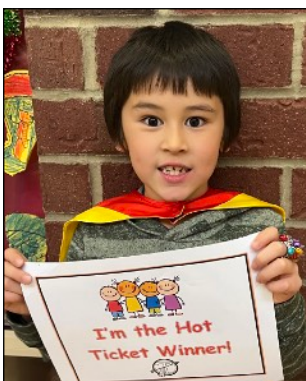
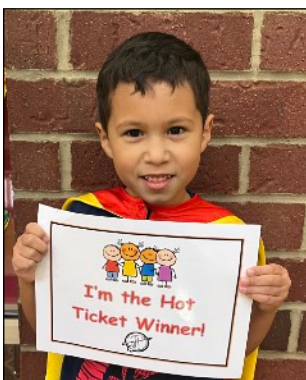
Donnelsville Third Graders Perform December 8

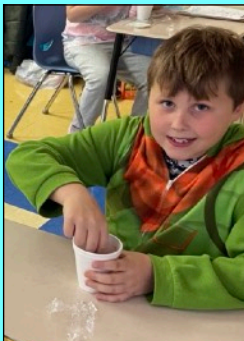
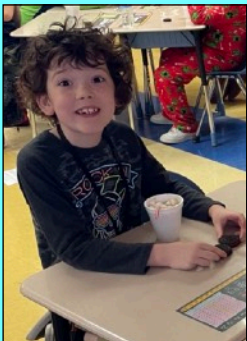


Park Layne Elementary Students Enjoy Kona Ice Reward
