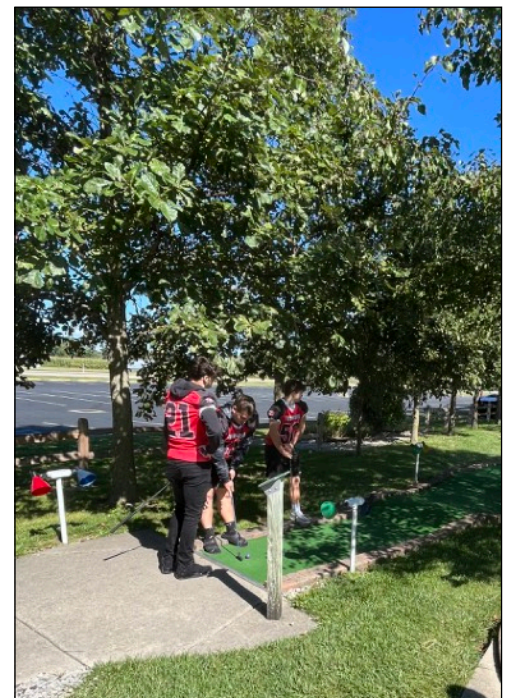
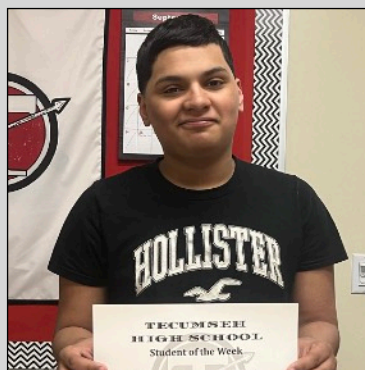
THS Students of the Week for Sept 25

TLS Shows Spirit in Annual Homecoming Banner Contest



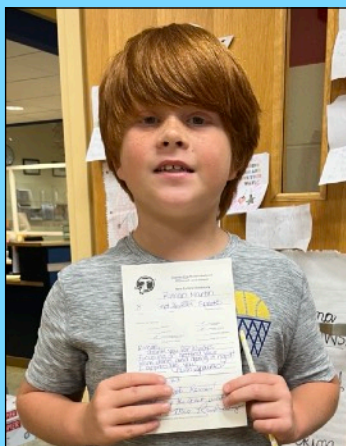
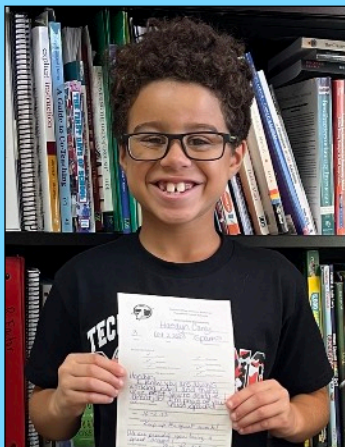
**1st Place - Tecumseh High School Artistic Arrows-

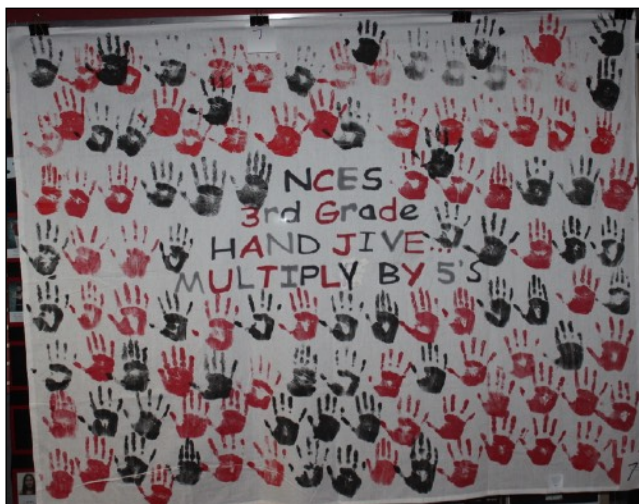

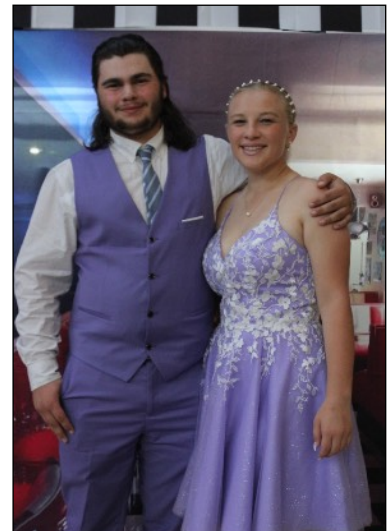
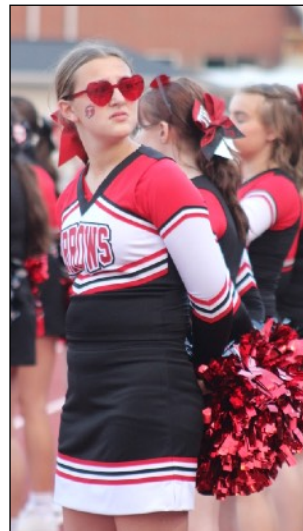
Homecoming Spirit Takes Over
