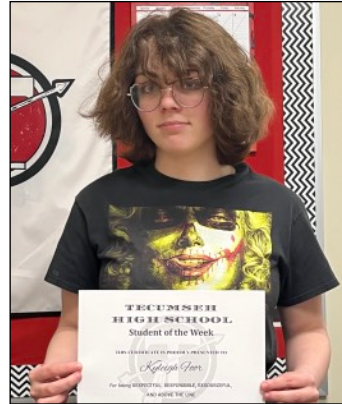
This Saturday, March 18, the cast of *Cinderella* will be hosting a tea party fundraiser at THS where the community can meet the characters and enjoy refreshments.
