- December 9- 5th Grade 7:30PM THS


ABSENCES

3RD GRADE STATE TEST

Next week our third graders will be taking the state test in reading / language arts. The state gives a test each fall to the third graders as part of the Third Grade Reading Guarantee. (TGRG) On Tuesday, October 26th and Thursday, October 28th, our kids will be taking the test. Please make every effort to have your child here and on time if they are in 3rd grade. This is the students first opportunity to meet the requirements for the TGRG. We should get these results back just before Christmas break and will share them with parents as soon as we are able. In late January, we will be administering an alternative test to any students that did not pass the fall test. If they pass the alternative test, they will have met the TGRG requirements. The state requires that students meet the requirements for the TGRG before they go on to 4th grade.

PARENT STRATEGIES FOR IMPROVING THEIR CHILD'S MATH

The staff is doing a book study starting in January based on Number Talks. Recently at our inservice we learned about increasing student comprehension through Number Talks. These talks that teachers can have with their students will increase kids computational fluency, help with their mental math, and help kids focus on number sense. This <u>article</u> will help you help

your child at home understand math a little more. I encourage you to try some of the simple everyday strategies listed in this article, at home.
